TROX has updated its design manual LABCONTROL – Air management with EASYLAB; the new version is available as of now.

Whether system overview or design details, the manual is clearly structured and explains all aspects of EASYLAB, including the wide range of applications. Easy to understand functional descriptions and suggestions for combinations with other TROX products are also included.

EASYLAB provides flexible room control strategies and can be used for fume cupboards and for supply air, extract air or room pressure control. The system is ideally adapted to meet the requirements of specialist consultants, HVAC contractors, lab furniture manufacturers and users, which is no surprise since their desire for simplified assembly, wiring, commissioning and maintenance as well as for expandability of the system was incorporated in the development.

One of new products that the manual now covers is the EM-IP expansion module, which allows EASYLAB to be connected to the central BMS via IP, either via BACNET-IP or MODBUS-IP, or via the integral webserver. The integral webserver is also used to configure the expansion module using a web browser. Another new product is the FMS monitoring system for volume flow rates, differential pressures or the face velocity of fume cupboards or other air management equipment. All FMS variants conveniently combine ease of use, data transparency, safety and energy efficiency.

The design manual also describes the new control panels BE-SEG-02 and BE-SEG-03, which can be combined with the FMS monitoring system or with EASYLAB controllers and are used both for entering data and for displaying status information for fume cupboards.
